## Community Cricket Coach

**3 year fixed term contract – subject to funding**  
**Salary £20,150 pa (37½ hours per week – flexible) plus expenses**

In conjunction with our partners Wesport and Active Gloucestershire, we are looking to appoint a full-time Community Cricket Coach to operate in Gloucestershire, working closely with our Local Authorities and School Sports Partnerships. The post will look to commence in February 2009 initially for a fixed term of 12 months, with a view to extending the contract for a further two years. Financial support has been obtained from Sport England, the Gloucestershire Cricket Board and the ECB for this post.

Gloucestershire has aspirations to drive the development of the Girls and Ladies game, providing opportunities for all girls to be able to enjoy the game at school, offer links to female cricket clubs and provide a pathway for elite players. The post will focus on coaching girls of all ages across all areas of Gloucestershire with an emphasis on developing District and County Squads with links to the full Gloucestershire Ladies squad. The postholder's main duty will be to work with local primary and secondary schools, to develop core sporting skills and to increase the number of girls taking active interest in and exposed to cricket, encouraging them to make the transition from the school to the local cricket club.

Basic working hours will be 37½ hours per week, including some evenings and weekends. Hours will be worked flexibly and working time will be shared between selected Focus Clubs across the County.

Applicants must have experience of coaching cricket with young people, and have a valid driving license and their own transport. You will be an ECB Level 2 or UKCC2 qualified coach (or overseas equivalent) with at least 3 years' experience of coaching junior cricket.

All applicants will need to possess:

- Excellent communication and organisation skills
- Excellent leadership skills
- Good IT skills
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team
- Ability to travel independently between sites
- Ability to inspire new people to play the game of Cricket
