# gloucester play rangers



Play Gloucestershire will provide a city wide mobile team of Gloucester Play Rangers whose mission will be to encourage children, young people and their families to 'Get Out and Play'.

Free open access\* play activities will include games, sports, arts and environmental activities & a healthy eating programme for school aged children. There will be a focus on 8-16 year olds. Under 8's are welcome if accompanied by an adult.

Green open spaces in Podsmead, Matson, Coney Hill & Kingsholm will be targeted in year one (2008). It is likely that Moreland, Barton and Tuffley will have Gloucester Play Ranger activities in year two (2009).

The Play Rangers are funded by the Big Lottery Fund's Children's Play Programme. The Play Ranger Team will be working in partnership with local community groups in each area.

Gloucester City Council will be sponsoring a healthy eating campaign through the Gloucester Play Rangers.

\*OPEN ACCESS PLAY: is provision where play is facilitated by staff, in settings where children are free to come and go as they please, free to decide for themselves what they want to do, why they are doing it and how they go about it. There is no contract between the playworkers and parents or carers to provide care for any duration whilst the child is present.
