Who can attend?

All sessions detailed are suitable for boys & girls
aged 8 years and over. Any age specific sessions are
detailed in the 'What's On' section.

How much do they cost?

All sessions listed are free of charge.

What can my child expect?

All sessions are multi sport activities. Sports may be
subject to change but include a variety of the
following; football, basketball, tennis, tag rugby,
cricket, rounders. Emphasis is on fun, safe sport.

All sessions are run by fully qualified, CRB checked
and first aid qualified sports coaches. It's easy to
get involved just turn up* for the sessions you want
to be involved in, no need to book in advance!

What should my child bring?

All sessions are outdoors; therefore please
remember to bring warm, waterproof clothing if
weather is cold and a hat and sun lotion if weather
is hot.

Please ensure that your child has a drink (preferably
in a plastic bottle) with them and any other
refreshments that they may require.

All equipment for each sport will be provided.

Please come suitably dressed, and wear
appropriate footwear (please note that football
boots are not required). Any valuables,
including jewellery and phones are
responsibility of the owner.

Other important information

Please be aware that not all sites will have
access to changing facilities, drinking facilities
or toilet facilities. Please be aware of this
when you are attending any sessions - remember
that the sessions are being aimed primarily at
those young people living in the local area.

*You will need to complete the form to
participate. It is imperative for safety reasons
that we have contact details for each child
attending each session. This form can be
handed to the coach at the start of the
session.

Please note, we do intend to run all sessions
advertised but if weather forecast is heavy rain,
they may be cancelled at short notice.
