### *Background*

Intelligent Health make physical activity a way of life through expertly delivered, measurable campaigns with long-term benefits. Beat the Street is a key Intelligent Health programme which engages whole communities and gets them moving, through a six week intervention.

Beat the Street programmes have been successful both within the UK and across Europe, commissioned by our programme funders, who in the past have included local authorities, NHS Clinical Commissioning Groups and charity partners. The schemes have been very successful, reaching over 800,000 people, but we know we can do more by working intensively with organisations to increase participation and once engaged helping people to stay physically active and be part of their community.

We are looking for a passionate, talented individual who can deliver a new Beat the Street scheme in Gloucester, focusing on the central Gloucester area. The individual would be responsible for creating an engagement plan which supports key priority groups to become more active and stay active going forwards; helps residents stay engaged with their community; grows social capital and reduces health inequalities in the city. We aim to make Beat the Street a fantastic experience for residents and funders.

### *Job outline*

The Engagement Coordinator will work alongside colleagues from Active Gloucestershire to engage community members, schools and stakeholders in the Beat the Street project in Gloucester. This involves introducing the concept to key groups prior to the start of the game, encouraging participation throughout the six-week game phase and then working with local partners to encourage continued participation in physical activity to create a sustained behaviour change once the game has finished.

There is also the requirement for the successful candidate to assist with the maintenance of our Beat Boxes, the walk-tracking Boxes mounted around the game area on lampposts and other street furniture items, that players “tap” to record their walking journeys. All of this work is completed with the support of our technical team.

This role is a 6-month fixed term contract working closely with, and under the line management of the Programme and Client Manager along with a wider project team.
